DESCRIPTION

Students prepare to become a video/television production assistant with additional training in preproduction and postproduction techniques. Instruction includes script writing, production planning, editing, use of video cameras, lighting, sound recorders, title generators, and duplicating equipment. This course reinforces skills in reading, writing, speaking, listening and mathematics and requires their application in workplace situations. Integrated throughout the course are Career Technical Education standards, which include communication, ethics and interpersonal skills, critical thinking and problem solving, safety, technology, and other employment skills.

EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

TECHNICAL SKILLS

- ▶ Demonstrate awareness of industry standards; observe all safety regulations.
- ▶ Discuss camera types; demonstrate safe use and care of cameras.
- ▶ Participate in recording/erasing/re-recording; handling/storage/maintenance of tapes.
- ▶ Develop multiple audio tracks; utilize mixers; explain Musical Instrument Digital Interface.
- ▶ Recognize types of lighting and accessories; explain maintenance and storage.
- ▶ Develop an idea; outline a project; write a script; develop a story board.
- ▶ Shoot live production under supervision of teacher and internship supervisor.
- ▶ Implement music/FXs, titles/graphics, and TBC/Proc Amp/Sync.
- ▶ Complete editing executions; utilize multi-machine controls.
- ▶ Utilize sound/FXs; implement titles/colors; apply graphic animation.
- ▶ Demonstrate knowledge of electronic integrity, generation loss, and duplication legalities.
- ▶ Explain and apply functions of time coding generators, readers, and synchronizers.
- ▶ Explain and participate in activities and schedules for planning location shooting.
- ▶ Discuss composition, color, mood, lighting, selective focus, and pan/zoom/dolly.


